of Washington School of Medicine in 2002, and completed her residency at the University of Arizona in 2008.

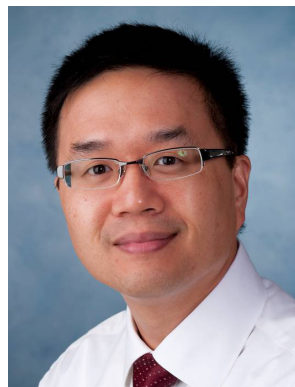

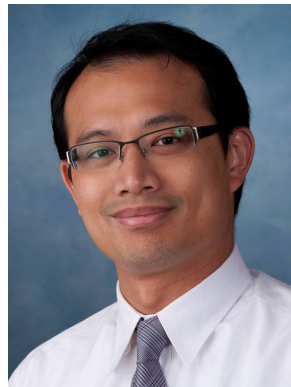

Creighton University School of Medicine in 2001 and Baystate Medical Center in 2004, respectively. "I joined TRA when

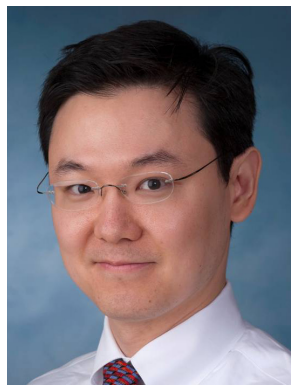

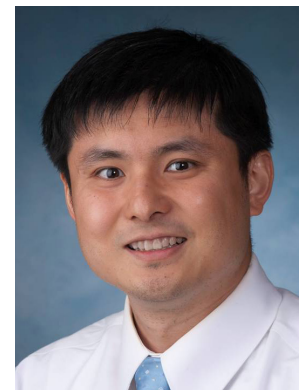
